



More Reservation Dates Available at Camp Tahigwa and Camp L-Kee-Ta!

A shift of the resident camp sessions at Camp Tahigwa and Camp L-Kee-Ta for this summer has allowed Girl Scouts of Eastern Iowa and Western Illinois to offer extended troop camping. In the past, resident camp has made access to our camps very limited to troops and service units during summer months. As of July 12, Camp Tahigwa is available for usage by our membership. As of July 26, Camp L-Kee-Ta is available to our membership. Let's fill these camps with your troops and service units!

At Camp L-Kee-Ta: We will have lifeguards at the pool from July 26 to Aug. 1. Any Girl Scout using the camp during this time, as part of an overnight reservation with her troop, may schedule pool time at \$1 per day per girl.

At Camp Tahigwa: Any Girl Scout using the camp from July 12-18, as part of an overnight reservation with her troop, may go tubing in the creek at \$1 per day per girl. Additionally, the rappel tower/zip line will be offered to troops for \$2 per three-hour period per girl. Ranger Gene can do hay rack rides in the evening, too!

If you would like to participate in any of these additional opportunities, advance reservations will need to be made along with your camping reservation.
