The Camp Tahigwa Resident Camper Extravaganza will be from 7 p.m. Saturday, Oct. 10 to 10 a.m. Sunday, Oct. 11. The camp, owned by Girl Scouts of Eastern Iowa & Western Illinois, is located at 318 Tahigwa Drive in rural Dorchester, Iowa.

Girls in grades 2-12 who attended summer resident camp over the summer this year may participate in the event, which will include games, camp songs, a hike and camp crafts.
